

SELD is committed to improving its services by building capacity at all levels, establishing robust governance systems, and integrating technology to achieve better educational outcomes at the grassroots level. It aims to expand access to quality early childhood care and education, as well as primary and secondary education, to foster social cohesion and provide more learning opportunities, particularly for marginalized groups such as girls and women. 
SINDH EDUCATION MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (SEMIS)

The Sindh Education Management Information System (SEMIS) was established in 1991, taking over from the National Education Management Information System (NEMIS). SEMIS is responsible for providing all the necessary information to support the School Education and Literacy Department's management, planning, and decision-making processes. This information is crucial for driving key initiatives within the department.

SEMIS collects data from public schools through a structured questionnaire that focuses on aspects like physical infrastructure, student enrollment, and human resources. The data collection is carried out annually, with October 31st as the reference date. Once gathered, the information is compiled and shared with researchers, planners, administrators, policymakers, and development partners to aid in effective planning and implementation.

MONITORING & EVALUATION



The School Education and Literacy Department has established the Directorate of Monitoring and Evaluation to oversee teacher attendance and other key school metrics. The M&E department tracks student enrollment, infrastructure, and teacher presence to ensure schools meet required standards.

GIRL'S STIPEND

The Government of Sindh started a stipend distribution program for girls in 2001-2002 under the Sindh Structural Adjustment Credit (SAAC). The Reform Support Unit took over this responsibility in 2005. Initially, stipends were sent via money orders. However, the system has evolved, and now stipends are distributed through a biometric-enabled branchless banking system, ensuring transparency.





SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

SMCs are formed in every major and functional school to promote community ownership in school development. These committees are responsible for utilizing funds for repairs, maintenance, transportation, and cleanliness.

HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

HR-MIS Wing creates and updates human resources information at provincial level which consists of a central online database of all employees/teachers working in schools of Sindh. It not only provides an HR application system but also ensures a new comprehensive and integrated approach in the management of human resources in public services through the advanced digitalization of modern age.





SCHOOL CONSOLIDATION

To optimize government school resources, the School Education and Literacy Department has implemented a school consolidation policy. Under this approach, consolidated schools operate as campus schools, which can include adjoining schools, schools on the same premises, or schools within a specific distance.


The School Education and Literacy Department is continually improving SSMS by increasing the reach of school monitors and enhancing the application to ensure real-time data accuracy.








FREE TEXTBOOK








CATEGORY WISE SCHOOL STATUS











GENDER AND LEVEL-WISE ENROLMENT








CLASS & GENDER WISE ENROLLMENT







STUDENT FOW RATE - IN COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS YEARS






DISTRICT WISE AVAILABILITY OF BOUNDARY WALL FACILITY













DISTRICT-WISE AVAILABILITY OF ELECTRICITY FACILITY




DISTRICT WISE AVAILABILITY OF DRINKING WATER FACILITY








TIME TREND OF STUDENT/TEACHER RATIO

HOW MANY SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN CONSOLIDATED?


The School Consolidation Policy in Sindh, Pakistan, is a strategic initiative developed by the Sindh Education and Literacy Department to enhance the quality and efficiency of the education system. This policy involves merging smaller, under-resourced schools into larger, well-equipped institutions, creating a more robust learning environment. By consolidating schools, the initiative aims to optimize resources, improve educational standards, and offer enhanced facilities for both students and teachers.

Under the policy, consolidated schools operate as campus schools, effectively functioning as a single educational entity. This approach encompasses three types of school mergers: adjoining schools, embedded or same-premise schools, and schools located within a specified distance from one another.
