

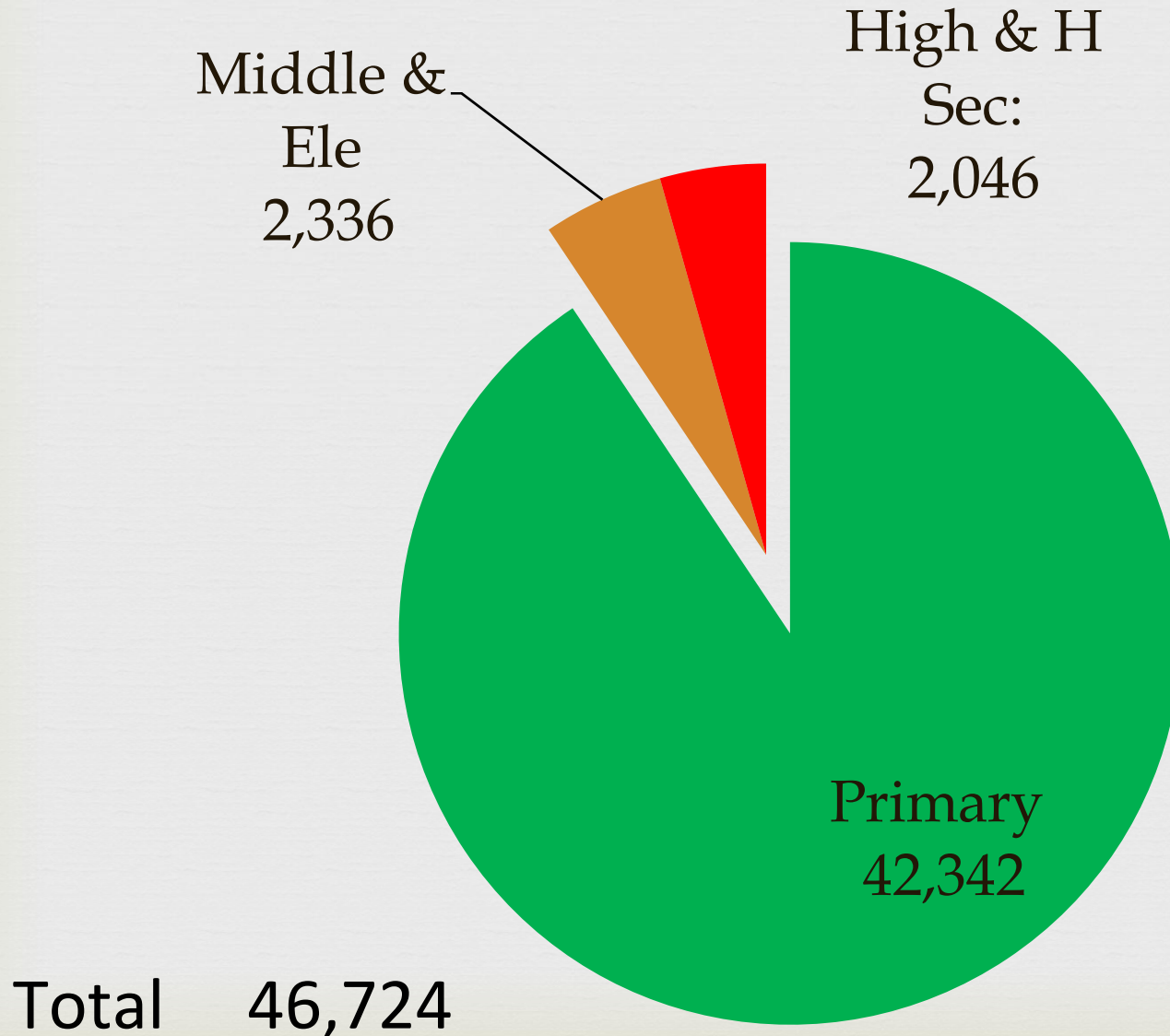

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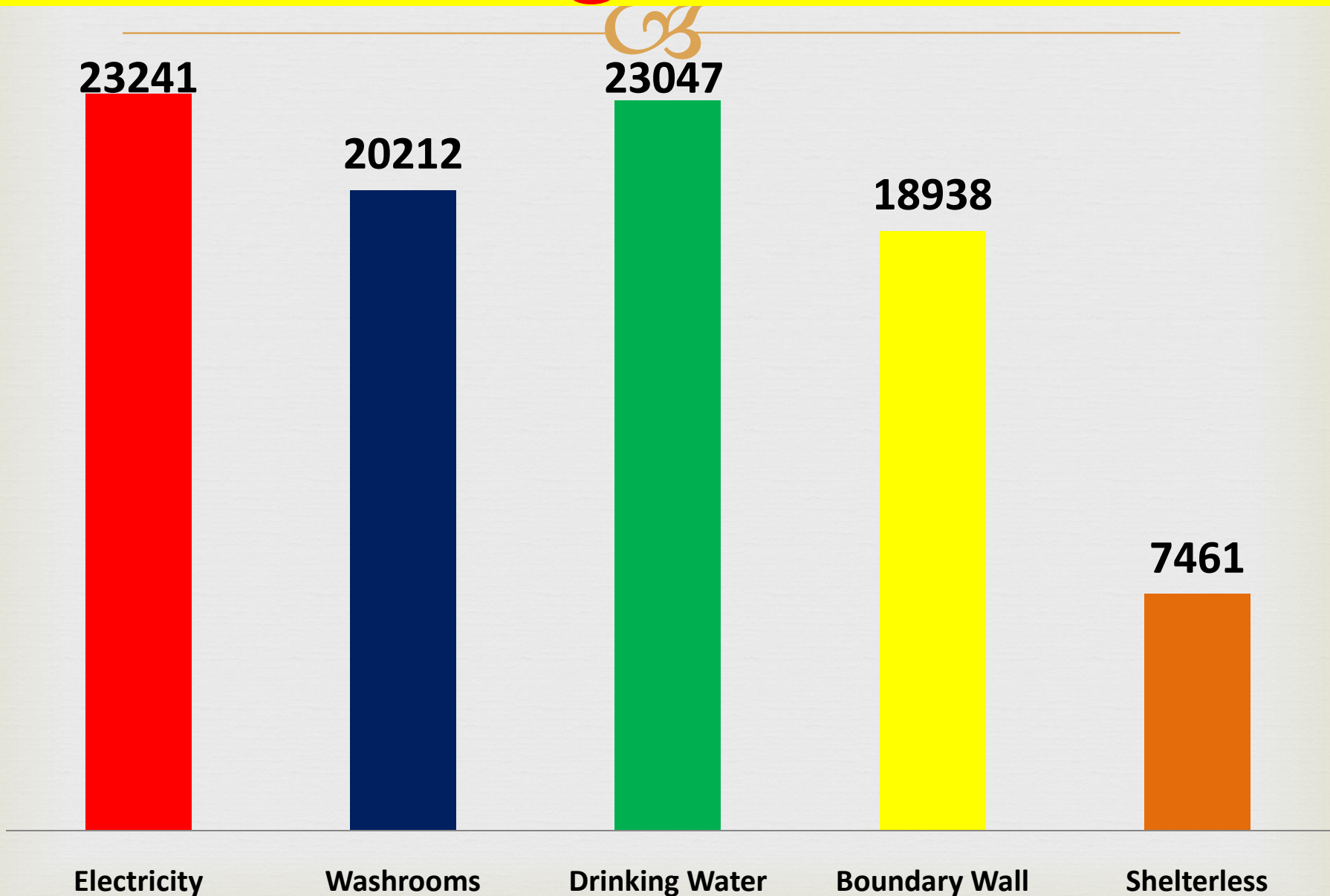

Free & Compulsory Education Act

- ❧ No child shall be liable to pay any kind of fee
- ❧ Private schools shall also provide free education at least 10% of their actual strength of students
- ❧ Ensure that the disadvantaged child is not discriminated
- ❧ Government shall provide infrastructure
- ❧ Monitor functioning of schools
- ❧ Government shall provide all training facilities
- ❧ Every school shall constitute a School Management Committee
- ❧ The Government shall ensure that the prescribed Pupil-Teacher Ratio

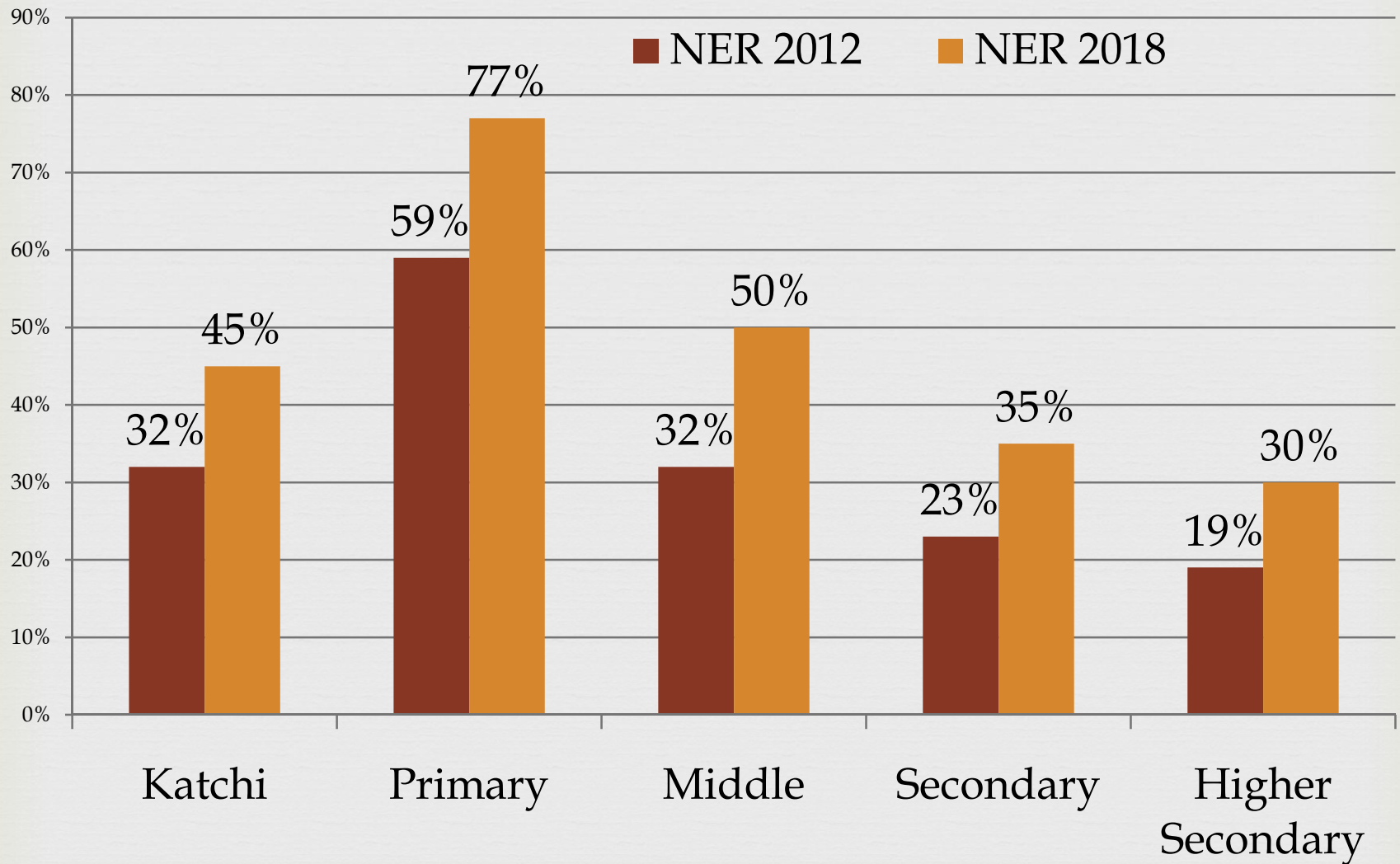
- ❧ Global Partnership for Education (GPE) Mission headed by Ms. Prema Clark visited Sindh, during 27-29, Feb 2012

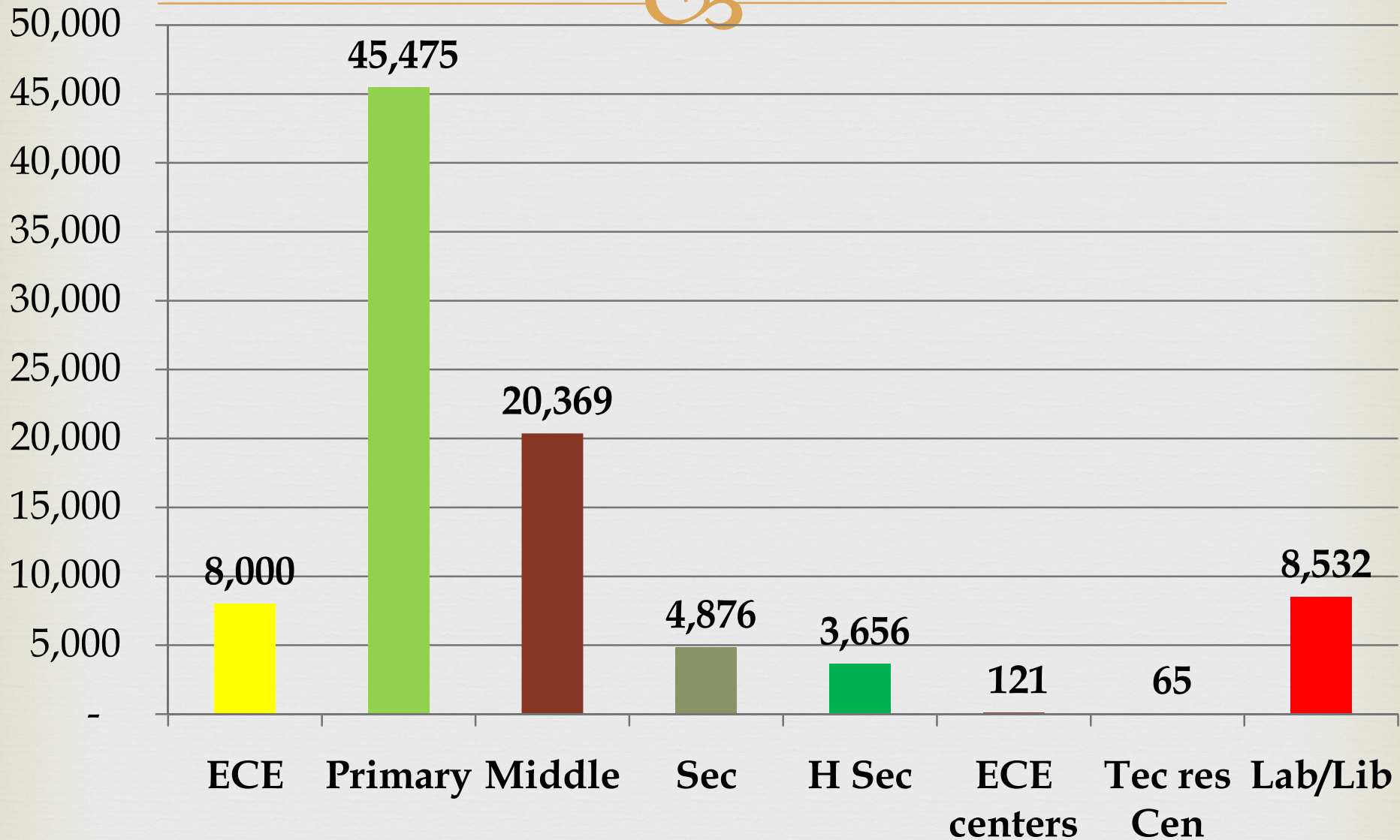

- ❧ 8121 ECE teachers recruited
- ❧ Review and revise ECE curriculum and provision of learning materials

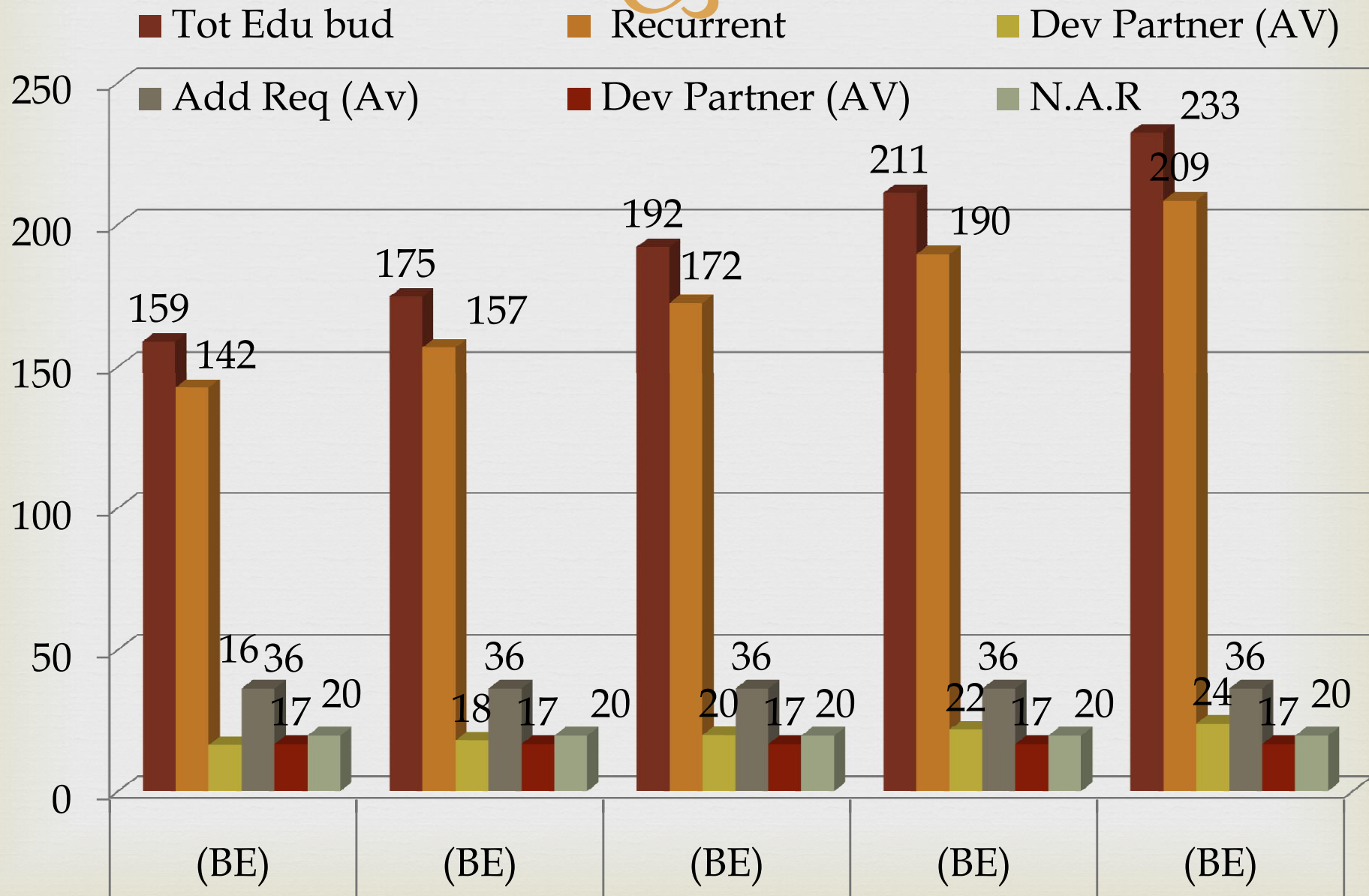
Costing & Financial Plan

❧ Total Gap in SESP	:Rs 186 B
❧ Commitments from Donor	:Rs 84 B
❧ Govt. Commitment for Additional Grant	:Rs 102 B

Implementation of SESP

- ❧ A task force has been notified
- ❧ Coordinate with implementing agencies
- ❧ Constitute sub groups / sub committees to prepare work plans
- ❧ Review from time to time the progress
- ❧ Coordinate with the other line departments
- ❧ Prepare oversight report on quarterly basis
- ❧ Oversee and monitor the progress and performance
