Corruption in public schools by Girls' Stipend distribution team in Sindh: Senior Program Manager, RSU, E&LD

Karachi, 20 Nov 2014: "Girls' stipend distribution team is involved in corruption in different public schools in Sindh," informed Mr. Ghulam Nabi, Senior Program Manager, Reform Support Unit (RSU), Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh. He raided a school in Makli where Mr Azizullah Memon of distribution team charged Rs. 18000/- from Head Master of Government Girls High School.

Earlier, Mr. Imran of distribution team was involved in embezzlement in Government K G Girls High School, Dadu where he gave Rs.2300/- per girl student instead of Rs.2500/- or gave ATM cards only.

Earlier, money was transferred through Post Office which caused difficulties for parents and there were chances of corruption. Therefore, from this year (2014), Government of Sindh is distributing stipends through ATM/easy paisa which is absolutely free of cost. The distribution is being done by a third party.

"The stipend is given only through ATM card /Easy paisa. No cash is given", added Mr.Ghulam Nabi.
