

The Expression of Interest (EoI) must include profile of the firm along with last three years financial audit reports, firm registration certificates and tax registration certificate. The eligibility for short listing is as below:

- Overall demonstrable experience of five years after registration
- Registered firm in Pakistan under the relevant laws
- Registration with relevant tax authorities
- Not black listed by the World Bank or SPPRA to do its assignments
